

3 Day 2 Night Standard Kruger National Park Photo Safari @ \$1150 per person (Sharing Rate)

Single Supplement will apply if necessary (Will depend on size of group)

Day 1

Departing from Johannesburg Airport or Sherewood lodge around 06h00 a.m. We make the 4 + hour drive to the entrance of the Kruger National Park. Game viewing begins as soon as we enter the gates, and we look for giraffe, zebra and various antelope species on our way to the camp, where we arrive by sunset. Dinner will be prepared by your guide and may take the form of a traditional South African braai (barbecue), weather permitting. Alternatively, we may use the camp restaurant. Fall asleep to the alien sounds of the wild

Day 2

We rise before the sun and embark on a morning game drive in the Kruger National Park in search of the big 5 - lion, leopard, buffalo, elephant and rhino. These are known to be the 5 most dangerous animals to hunt, but we get to view them up close from the safety of an open safari vehicle. While looking for wildlife we visit waterholes, lookout points and beautiful picnic spots, stopping at regular intervals so you can stretch your legs and enjoy some refreshments.

After breakfast at a picnic site in the bush, we either continue our game drive through the park or return to the camp around lunchtime, where you can spend the hot midday hours relaxing at the pool, browsing through the curio shop or watching animals from the deck. In the afternoon we head out on another game drive and return to the camp at sunset for dinner. As an optional extra, you can embark on a sunset/night drive on an open safari vehicle equipped with spotlights, conducted by one of the Kruger Park's rangers. Dinner will be expertly prepared by your guide, weather permitting, and enjoyed around the campfire under the stars. Or we may eat at the camp restaurant.

Day 3

This morning we pack up early and head out on a final early morning game drive in search of game that may have eluded us thus far. Breakfast is served at a picnic site along the way, and we exit the Kruger Park around mid morning to begin our journey back to Johannesburg.

Included:

- Transfers from Johannesburg airport or Sherewood lodge to Kruger National Park and back to the
- 2 nights' accommodation inside Kruger National Park in the standard park owned chalets pending availability They are comfortable with all the amenities needed but nothing fancy, should you require more luxurious accommodations, please inform us and we can book at a more upmarket lodge inside or outside at a upgrade fee
- Meals included are 3 lunches, 2 dinners, 2 breakfasts, beverages and snacks.
- Activities as mentioned per itinerary, including all National Park entry fees.

Excluded:

- Gratuities for guide and lodge staff and personal expenses
